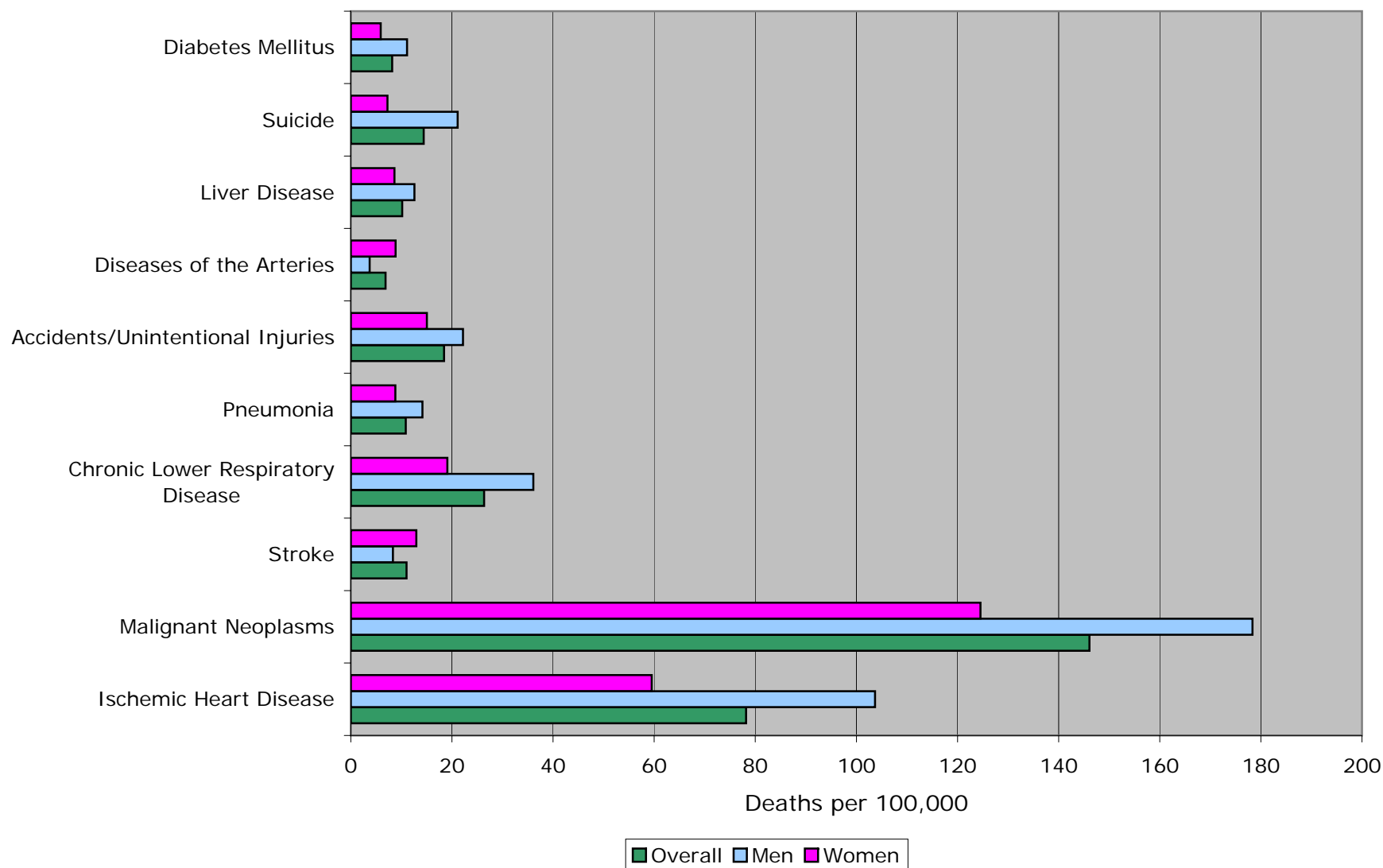

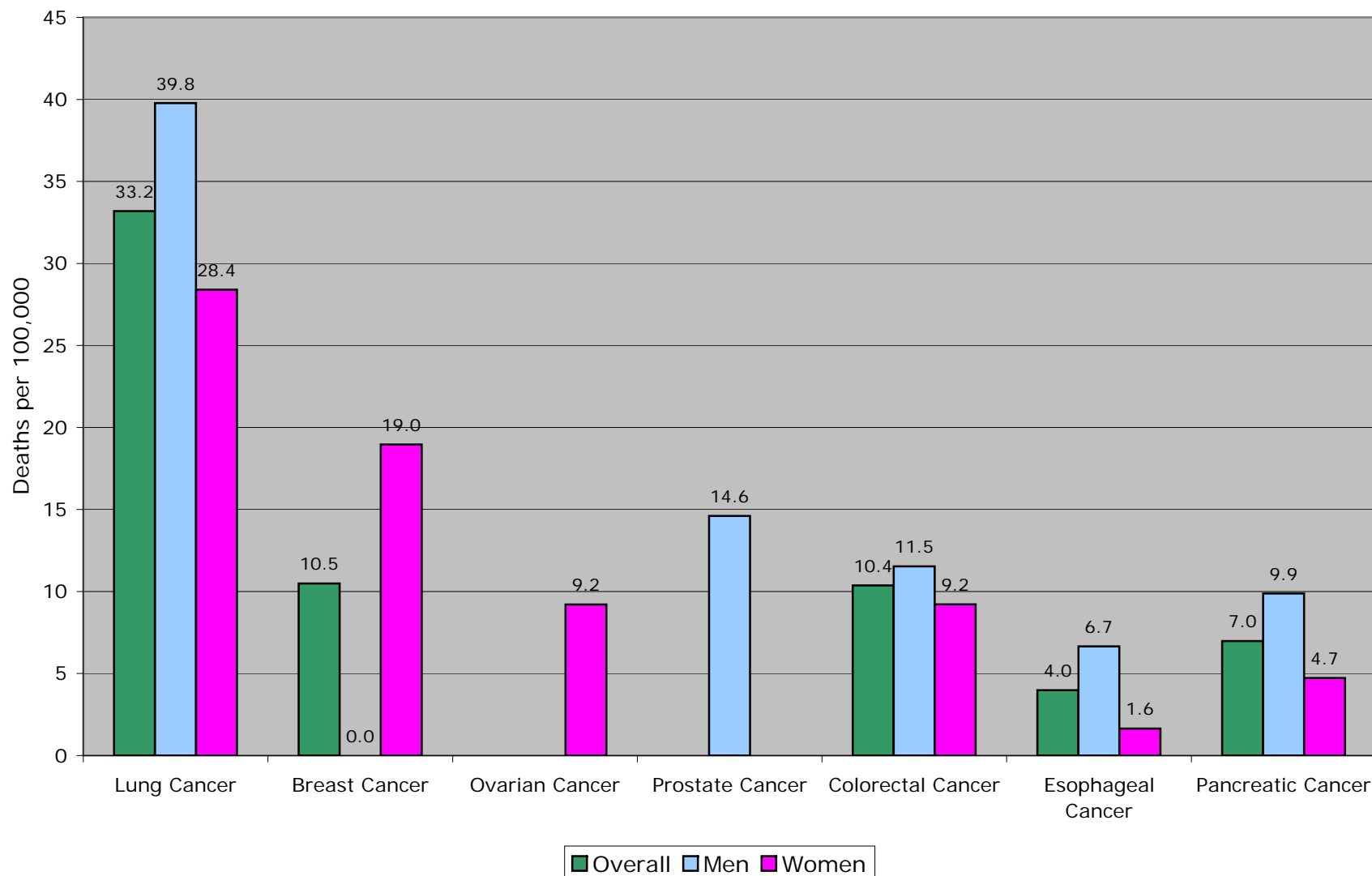

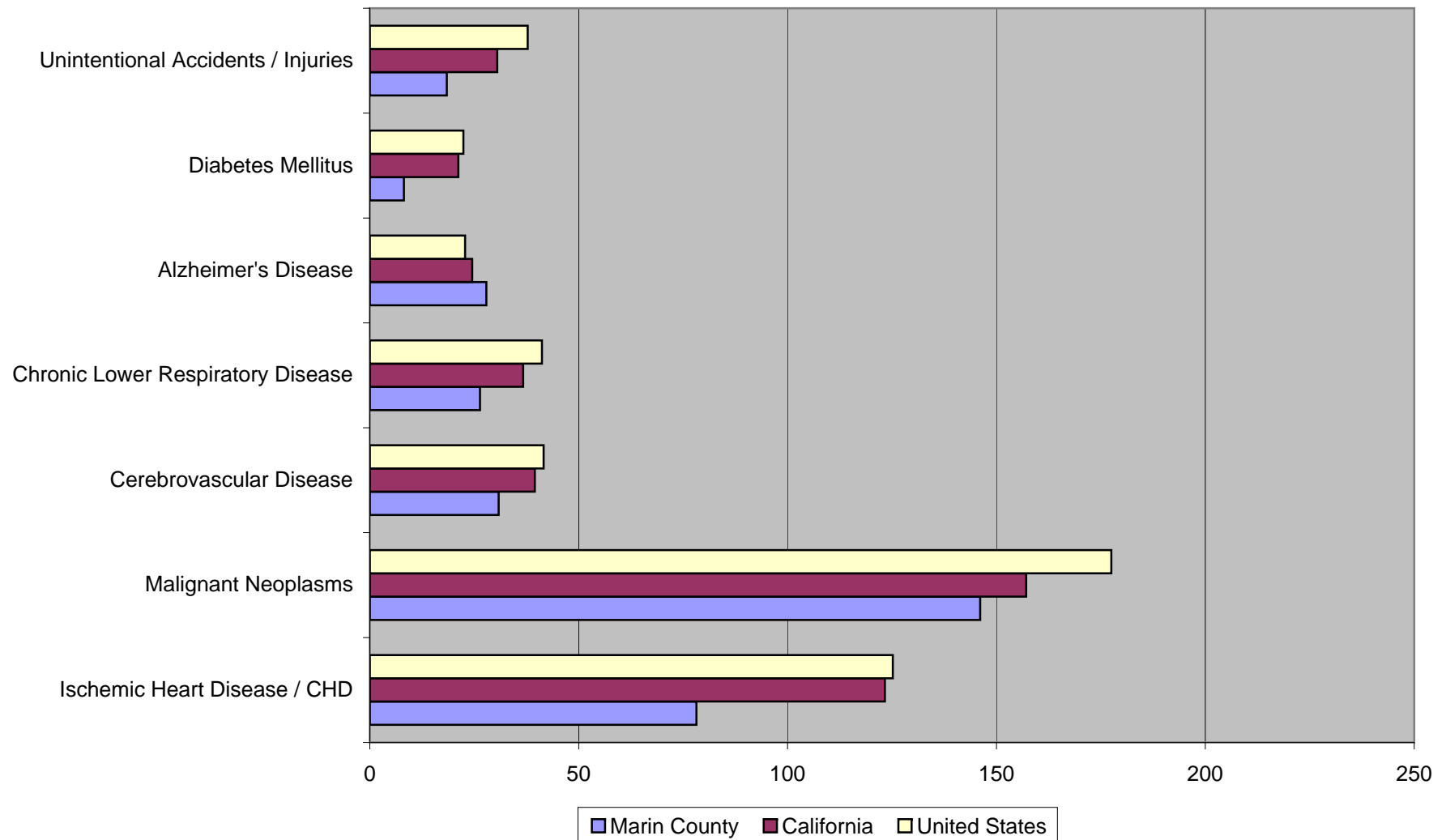
## Age-Adjusted Death Rates by Cause of Death and Gender - 2007



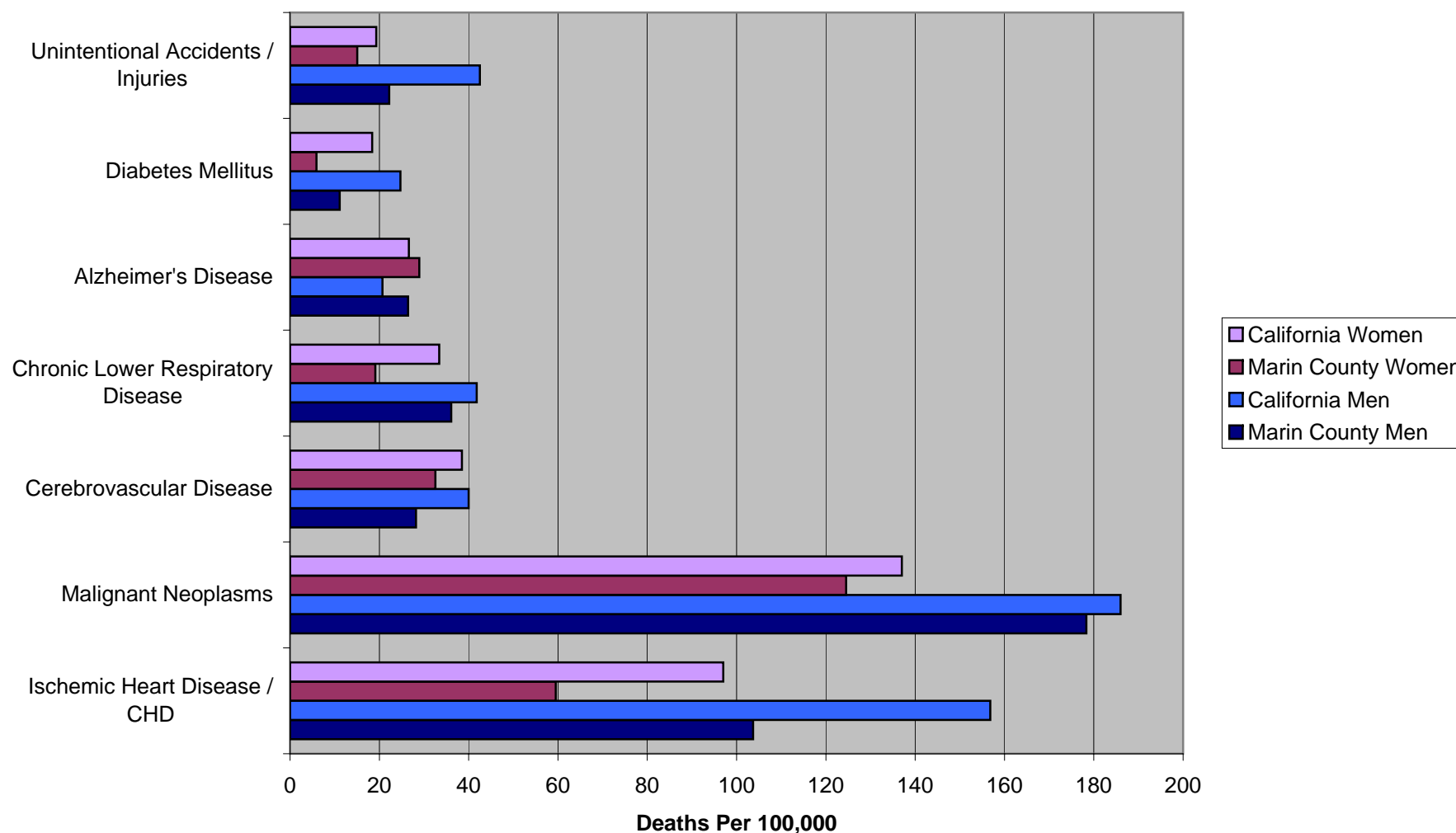
## Leading Causes of Death From Malignant Neoplasm by Age- Adjusted Death Rate - 2007



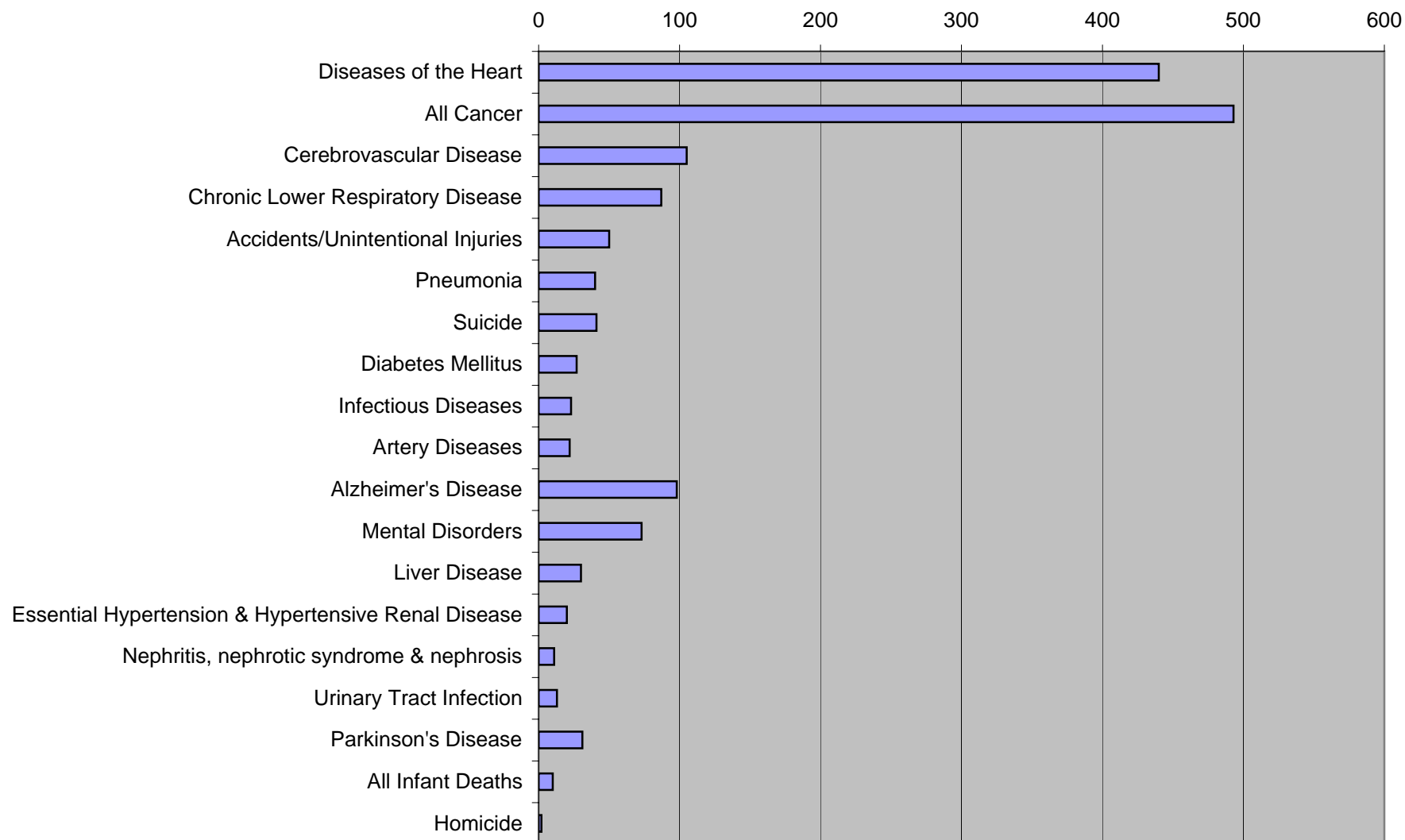
## Comparison of Marin County, California, and US Cause-Specific Age-Adjusted Death Rates - 2007



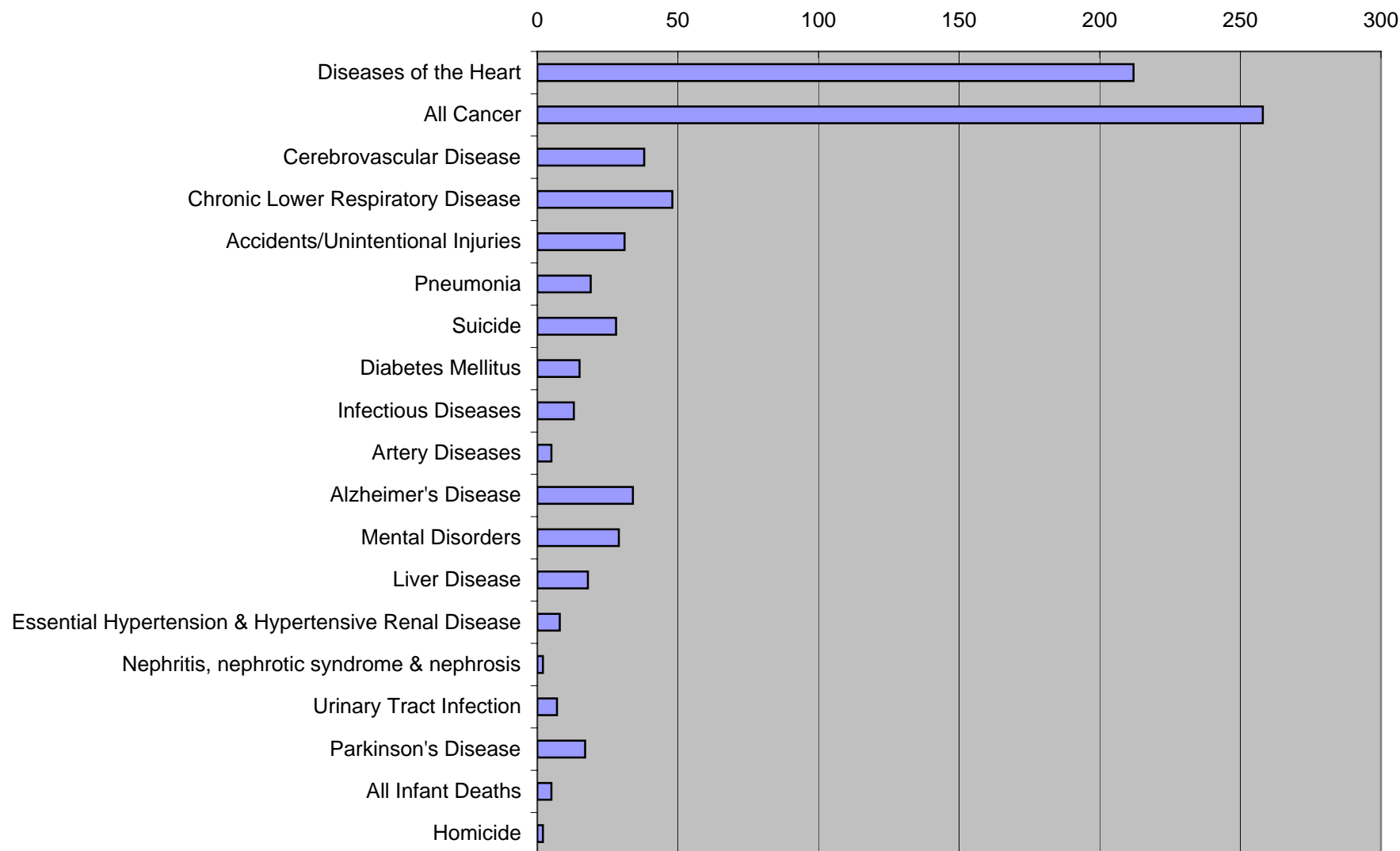
## Gender-Specific Age-Adjusted Death Rates in Marin County and California - 2007



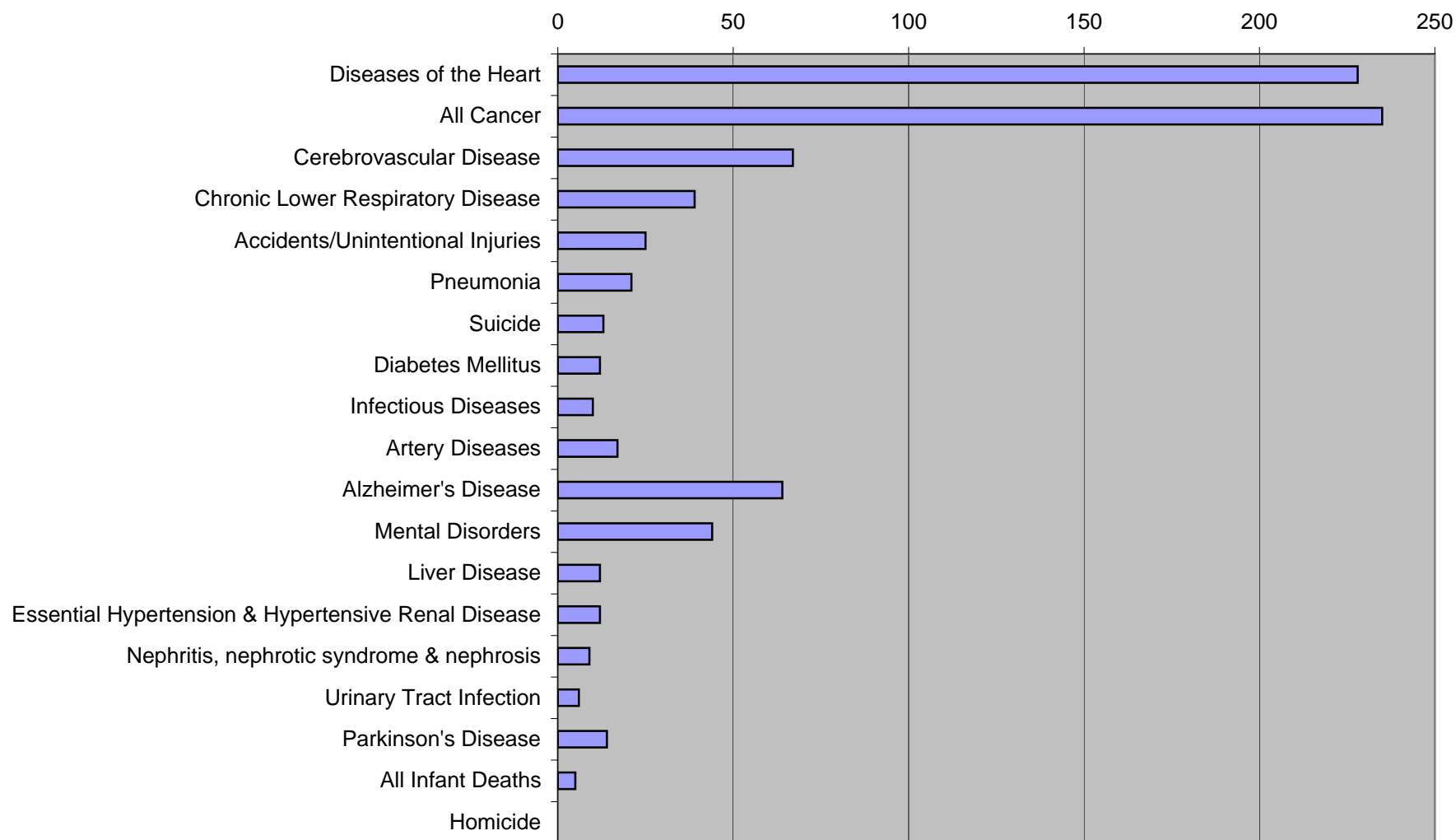

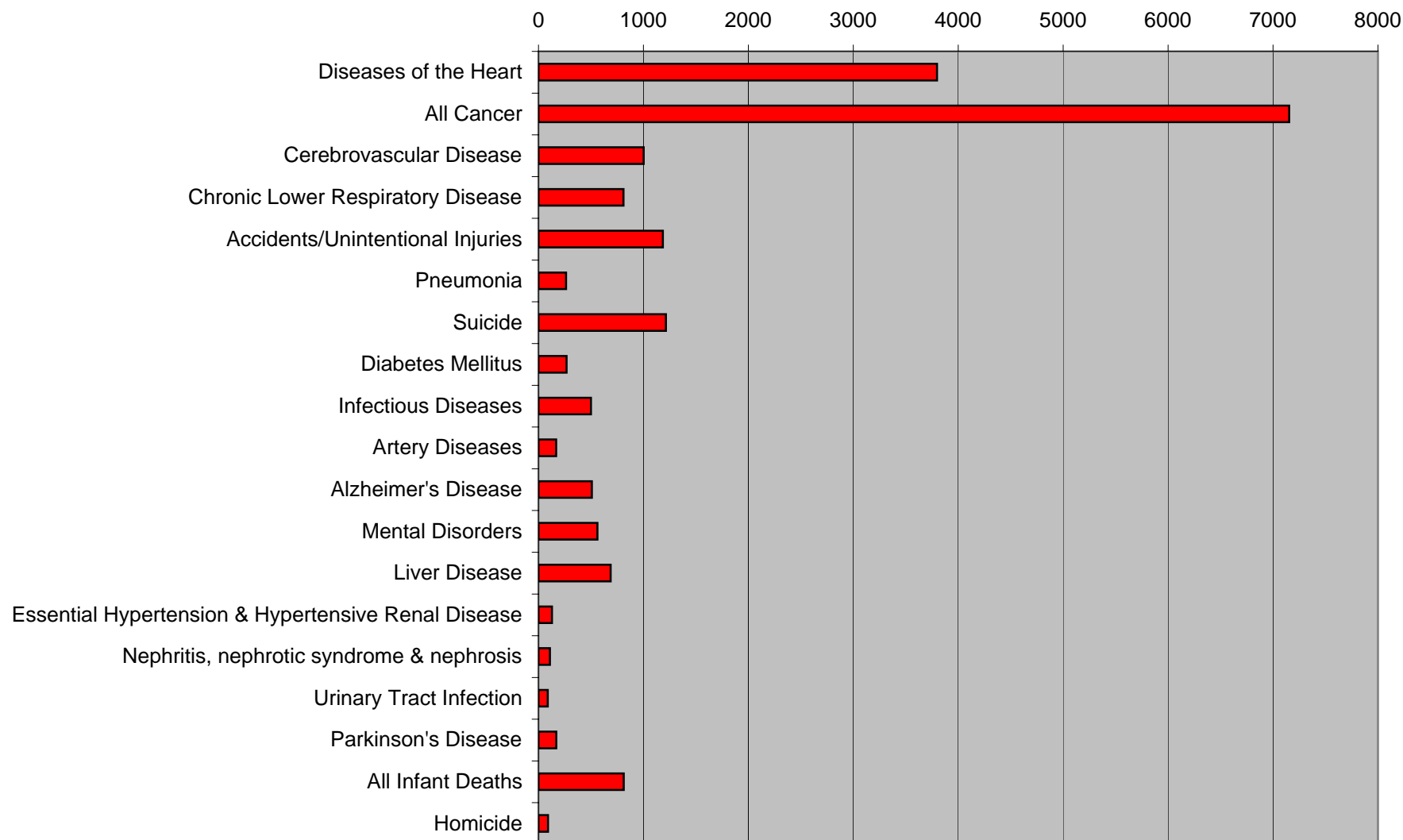

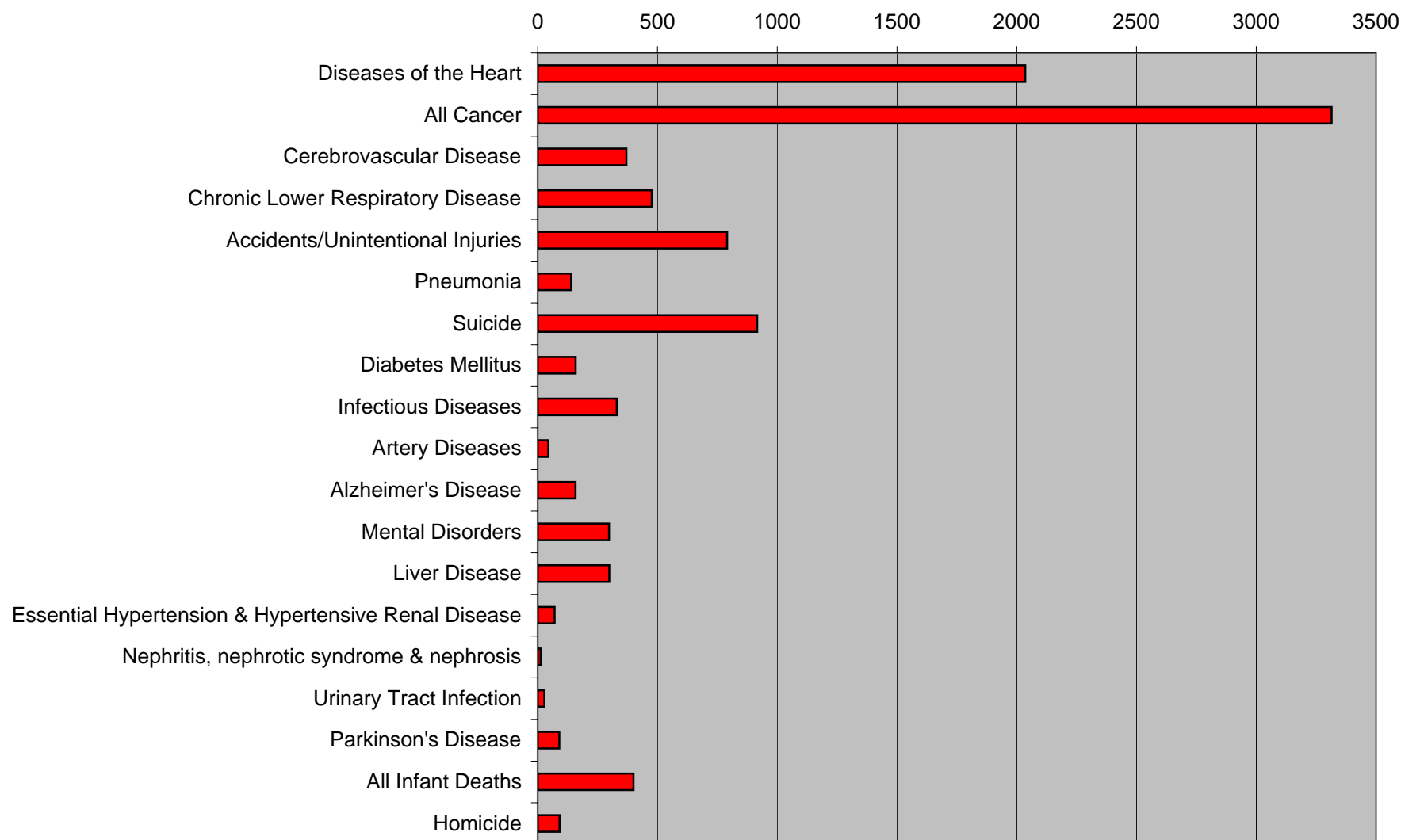

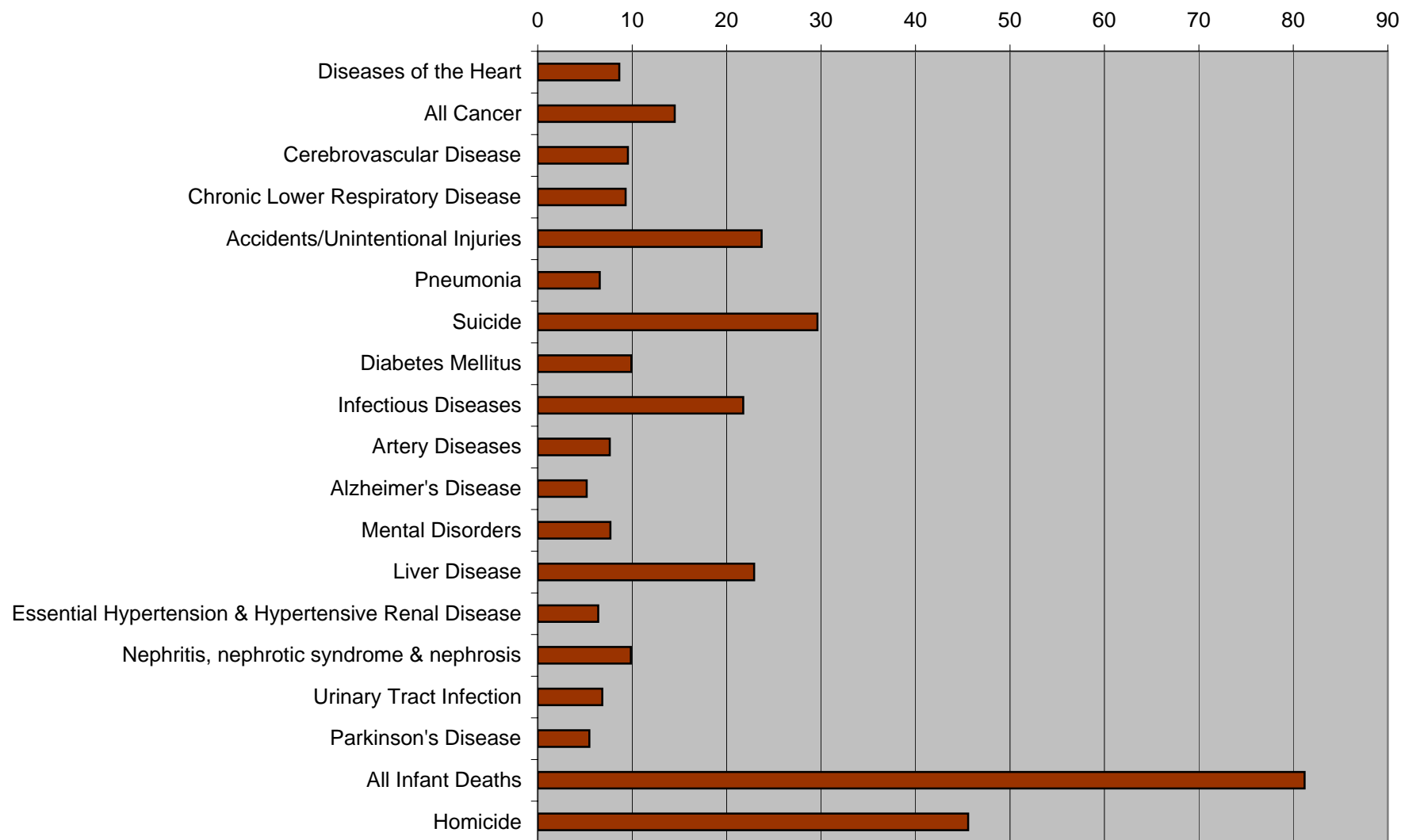
## Significant Causes of Death in Men by SEYLL - 2007



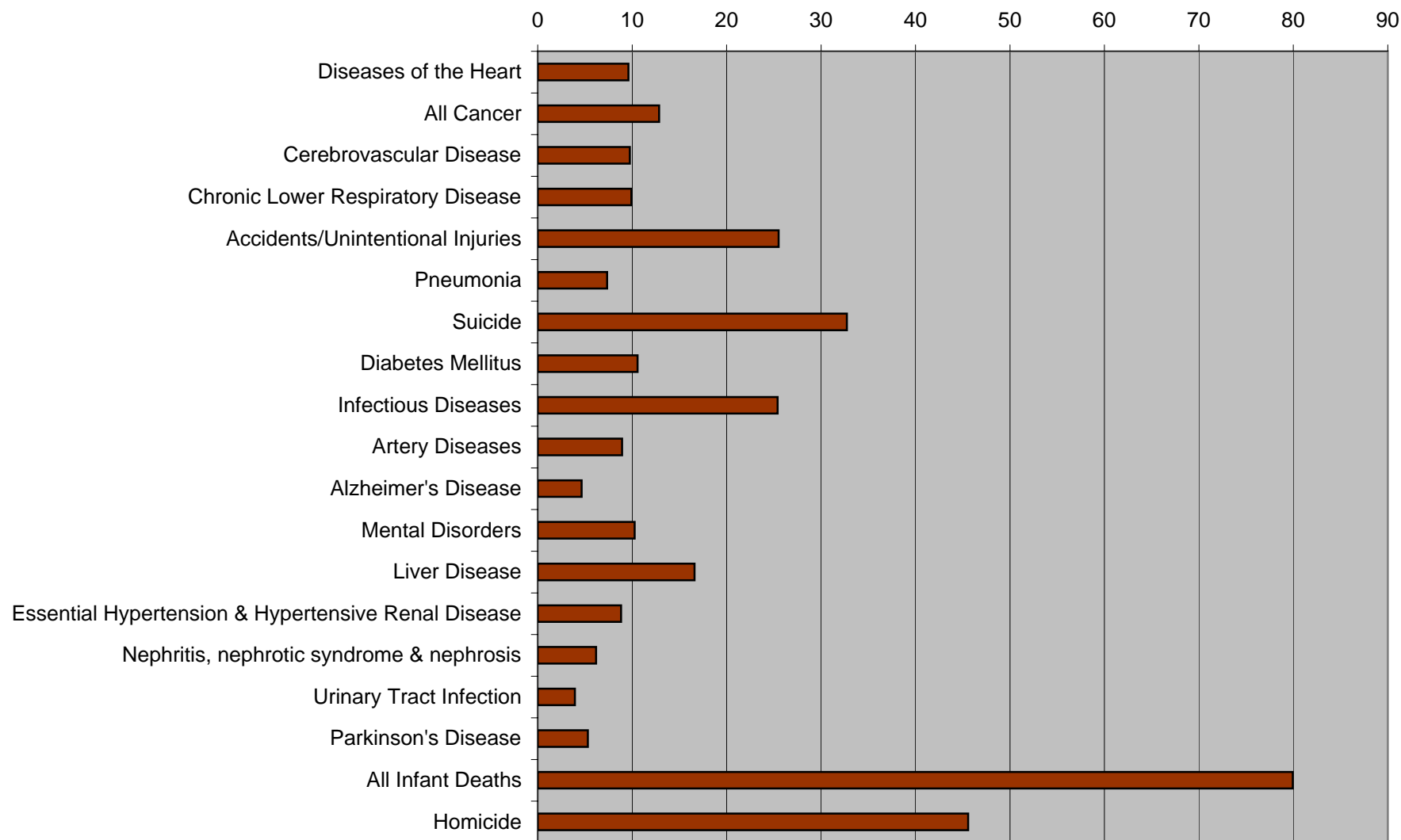
## Significant Causes of Death in Women by SEYLL - 2007



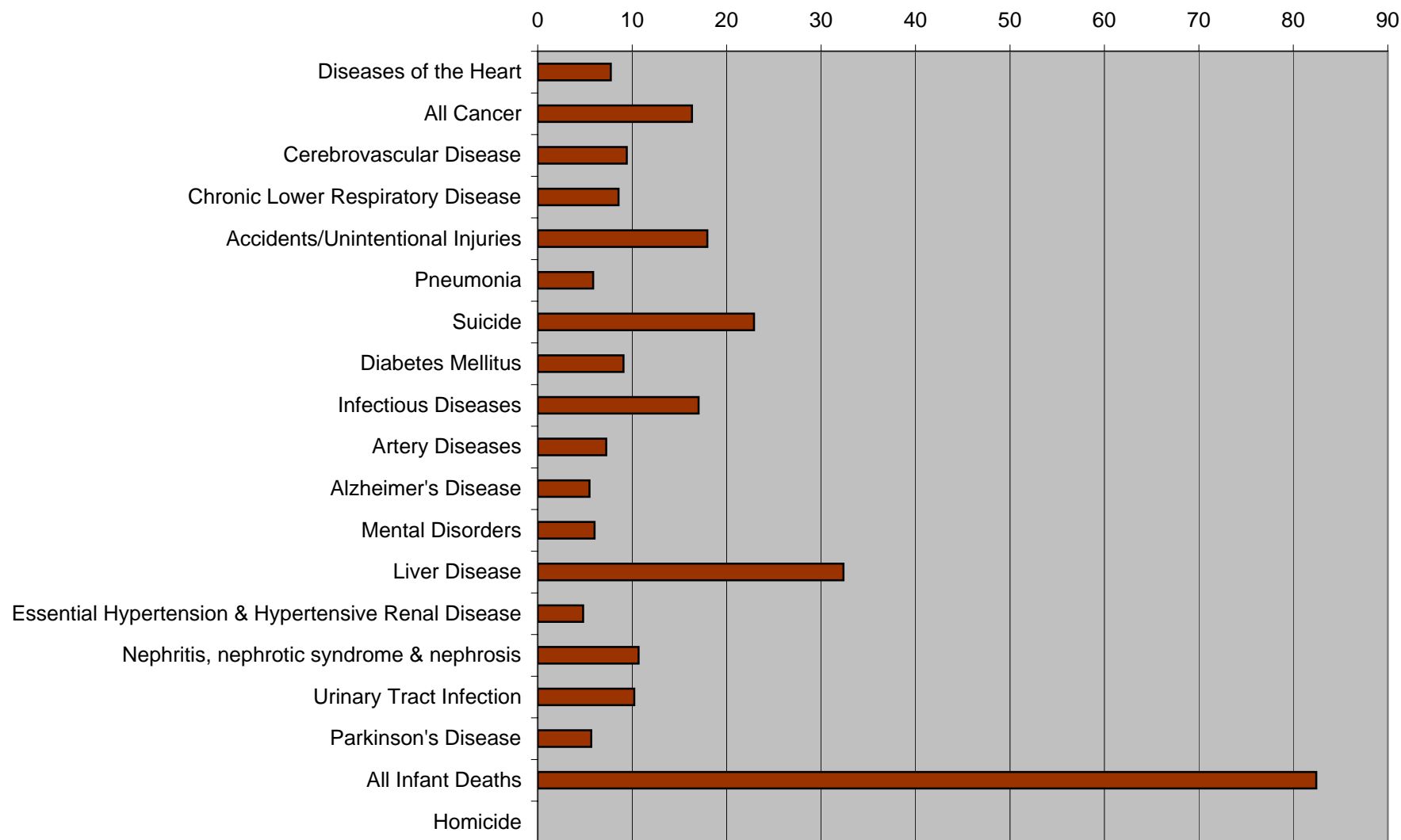
## Average SEYLL by Cause of Death Overall - 2007



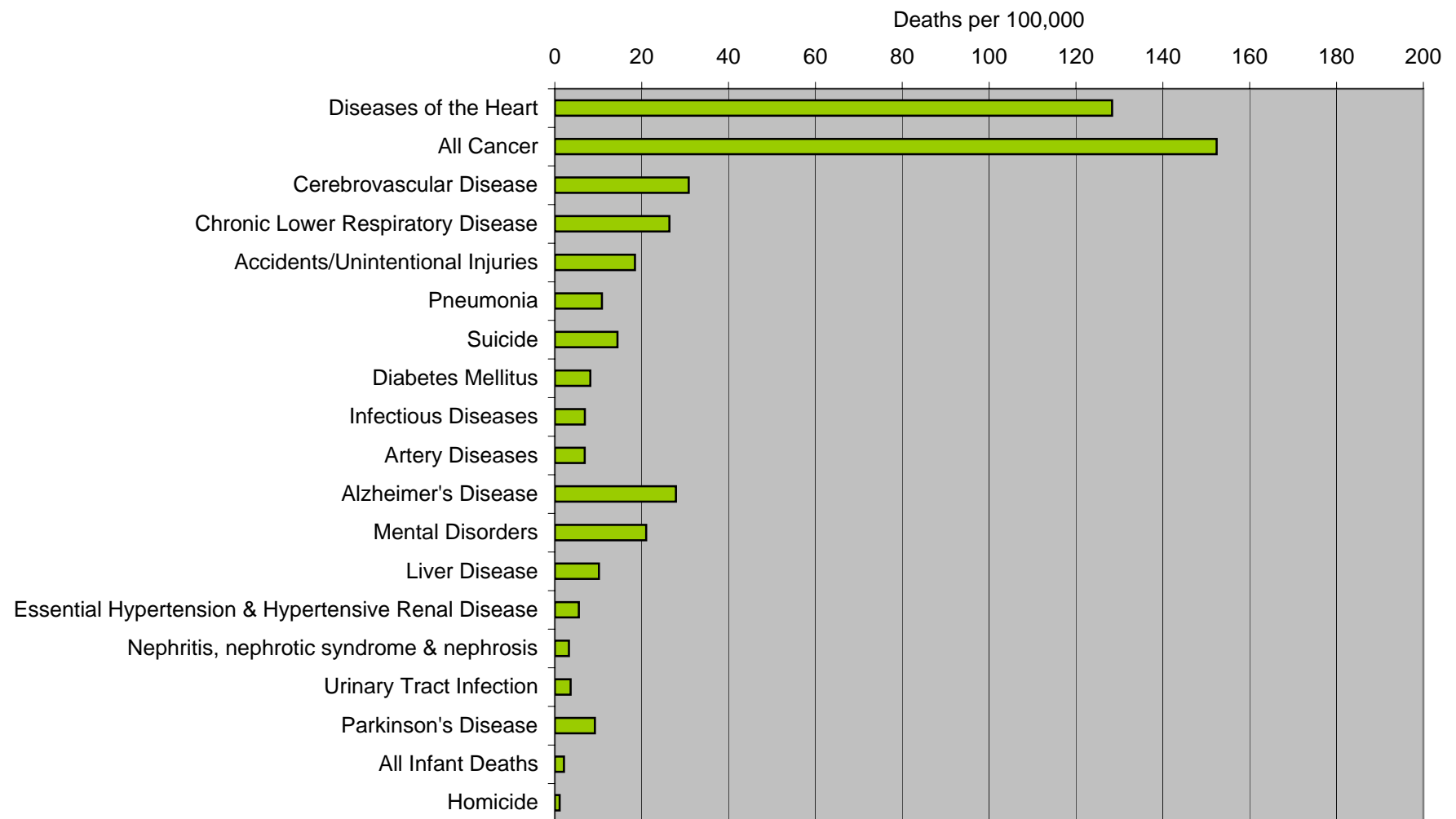
## Average SEYLL by Cause of Death for Men - 2007



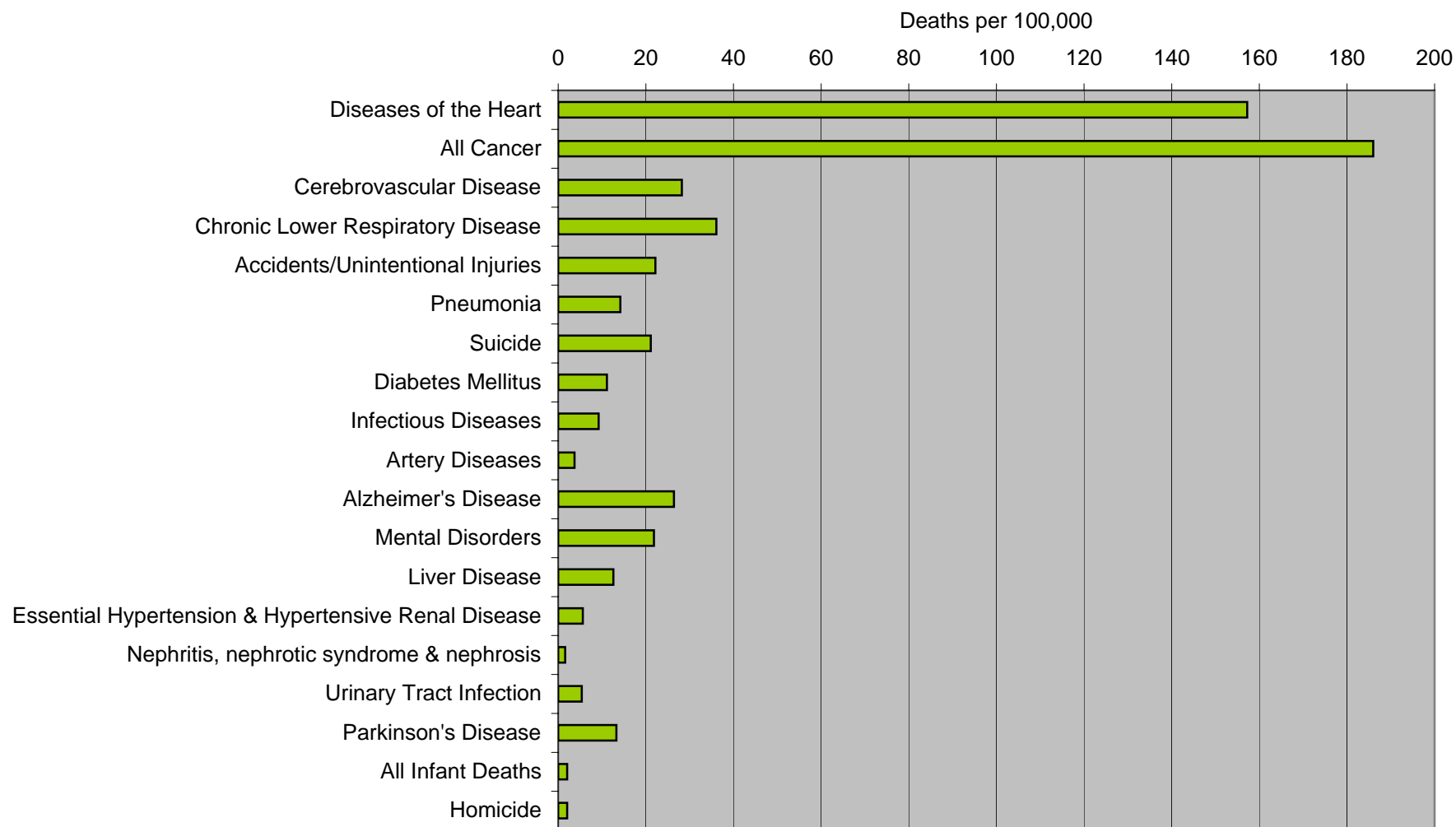
## Average SEYLL by Cause of Death for Women - 2007



## Significant Causes of Death by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - 2007

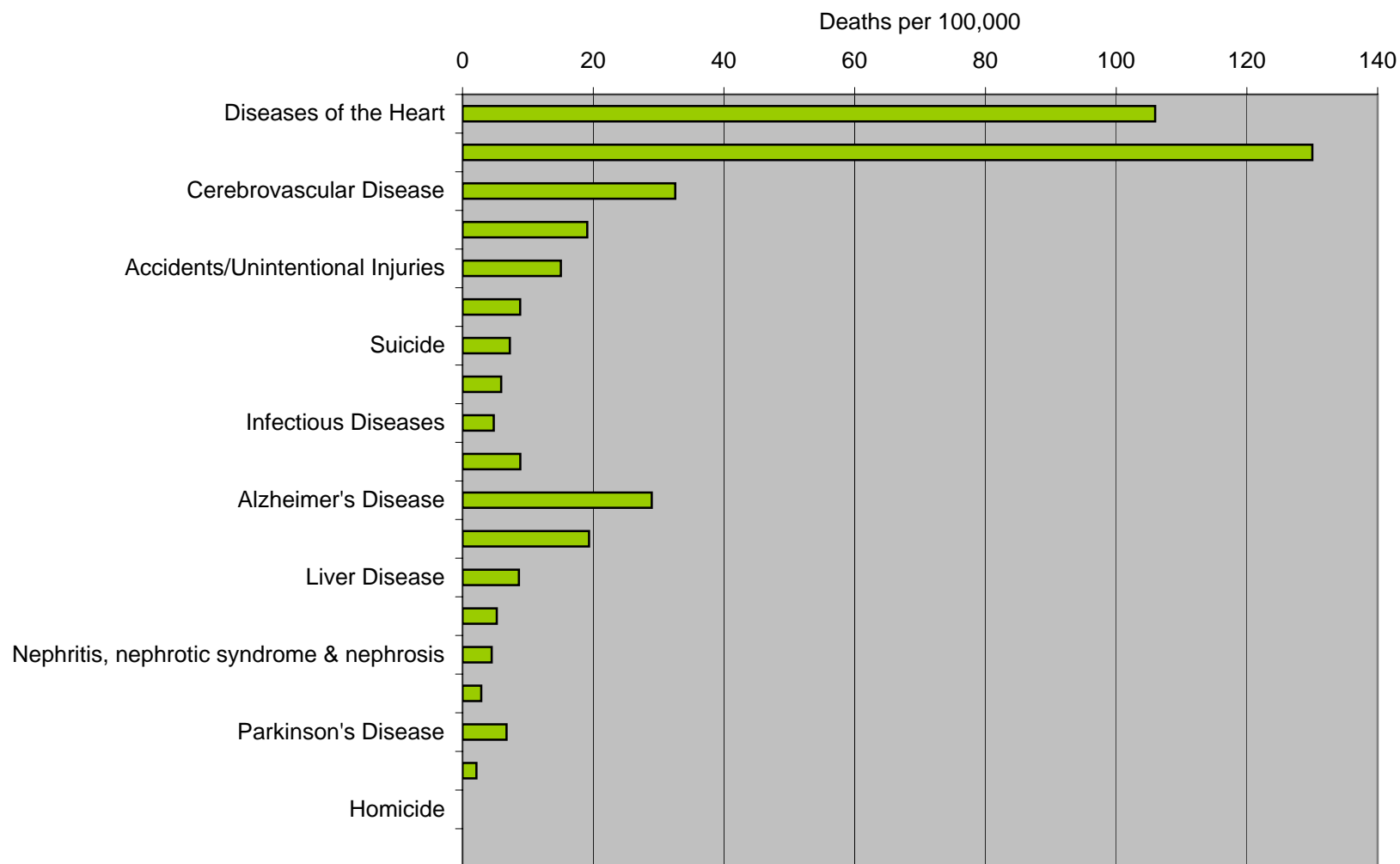


## Significant Causes of Death by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - Men 2007

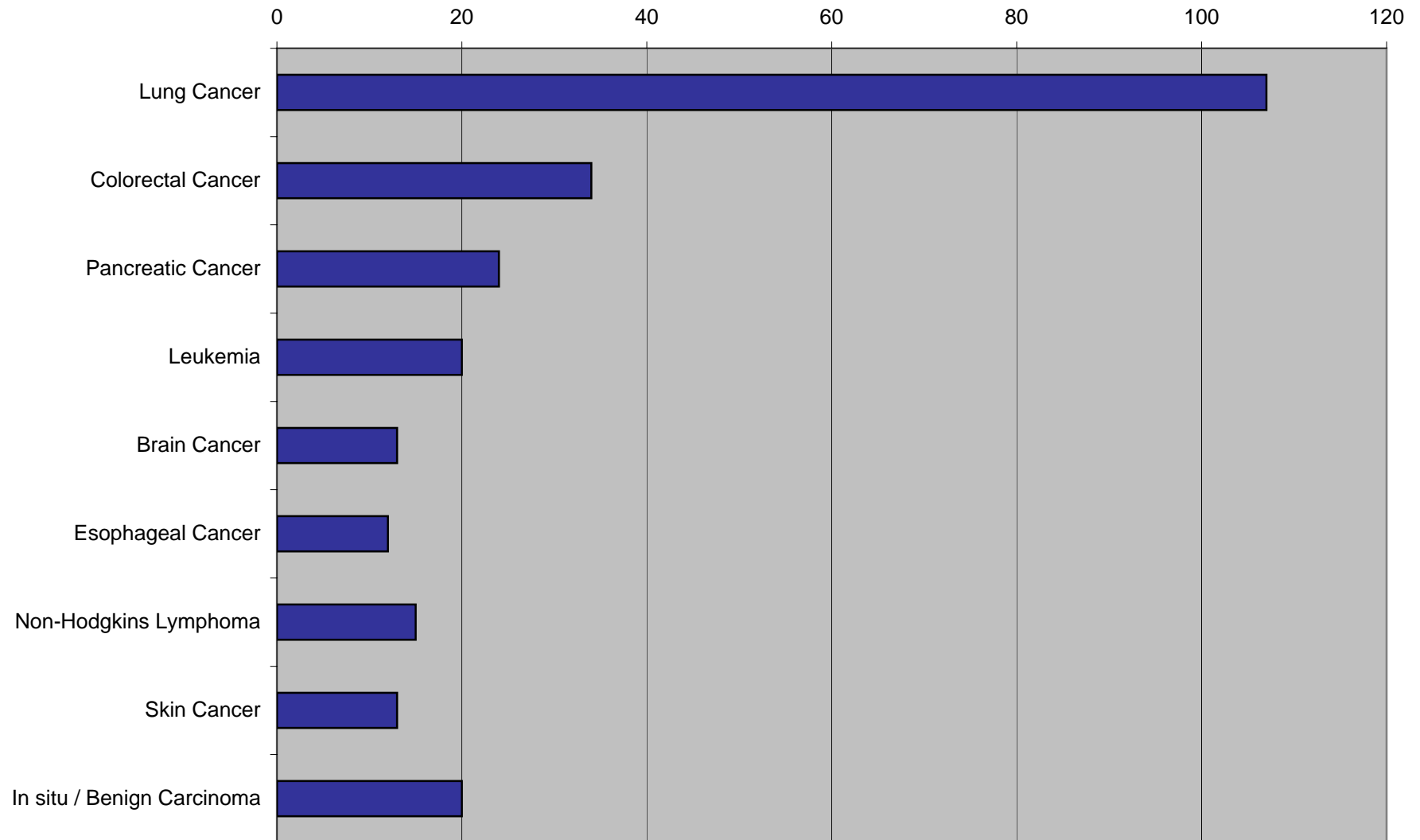




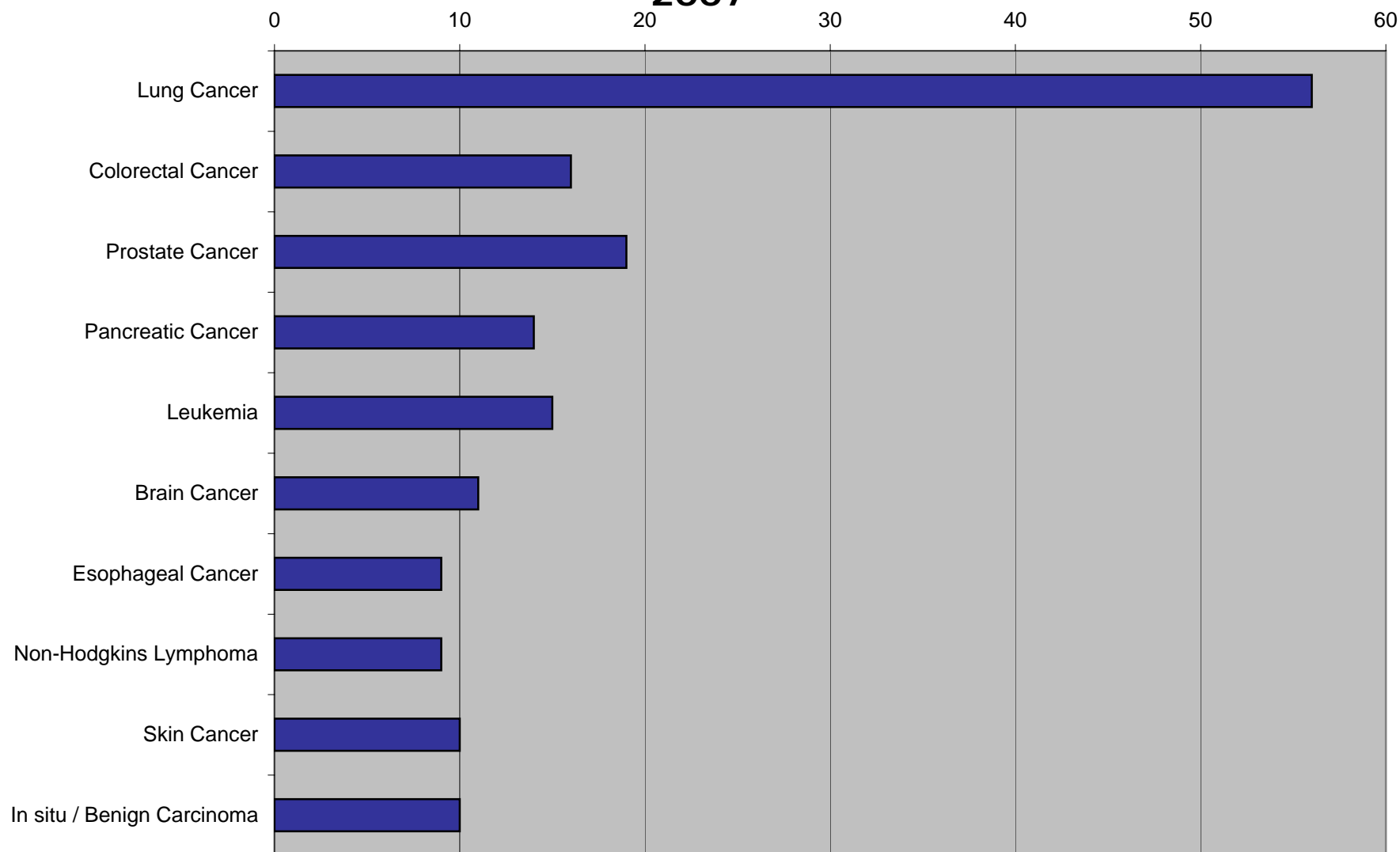
## Significant Causes of Death by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - Women 2007



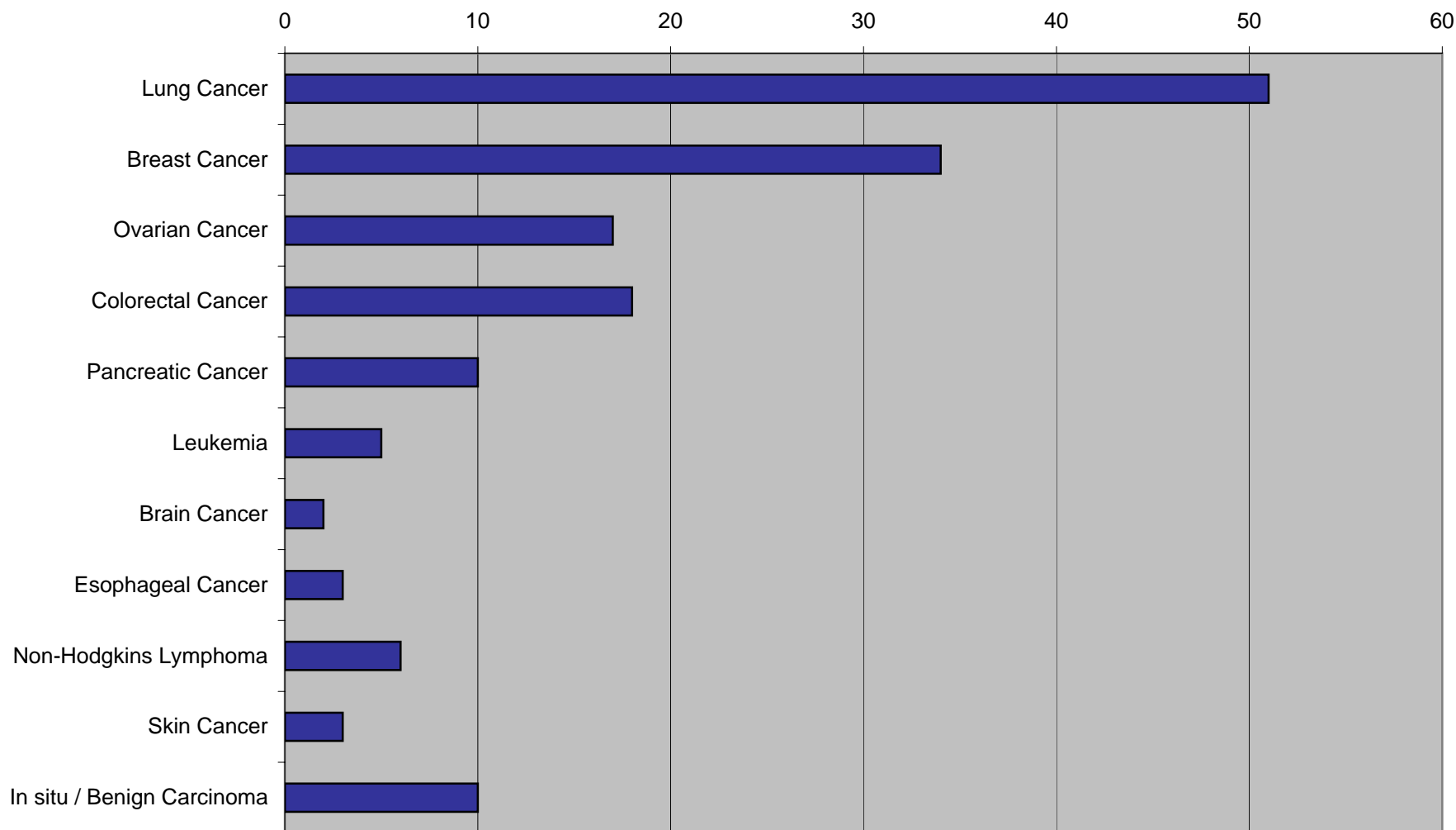
## Significant Causes of Cancer Death by Count - 2007



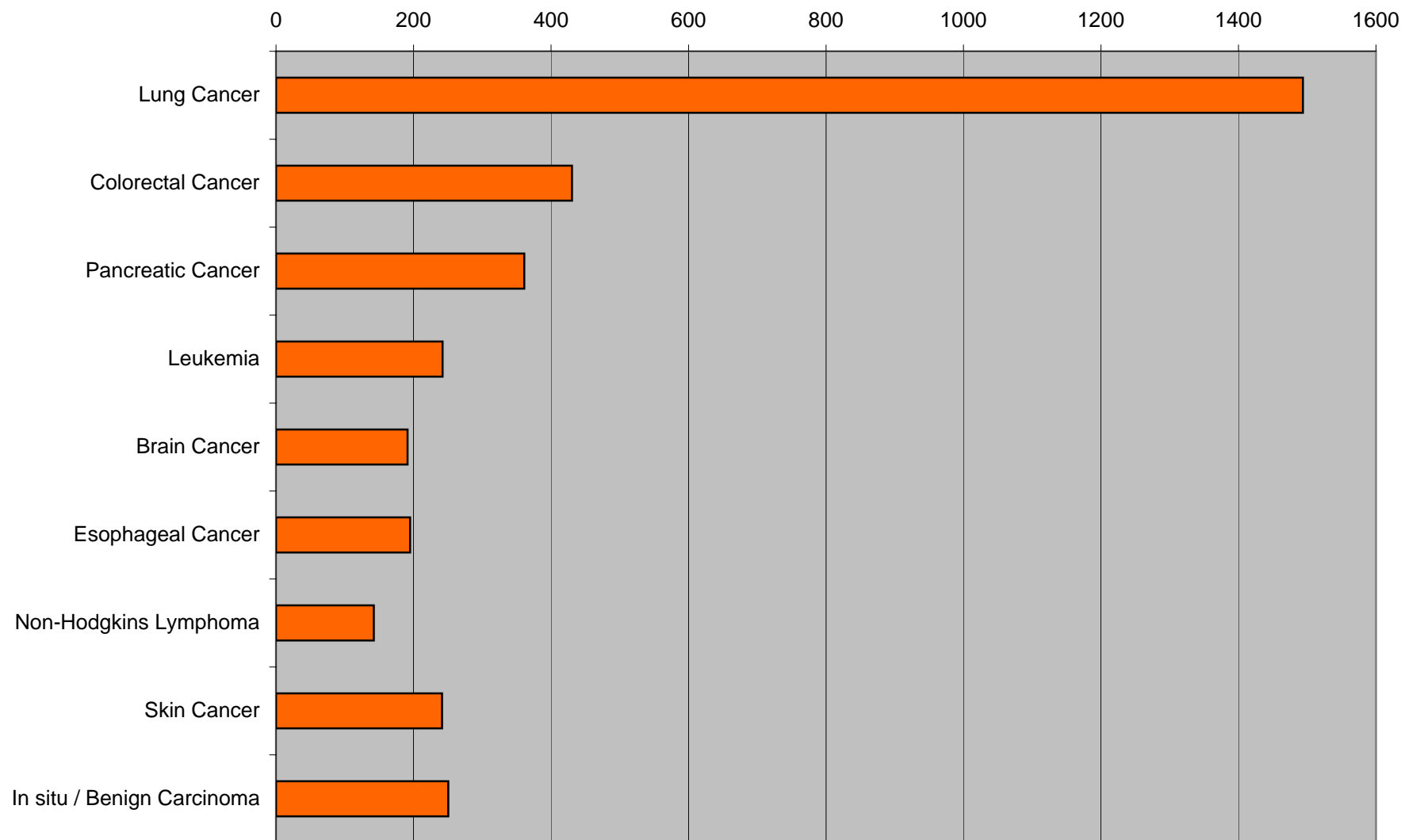
## Significant Causes of Cancer Deaths in Men by Count - 2007



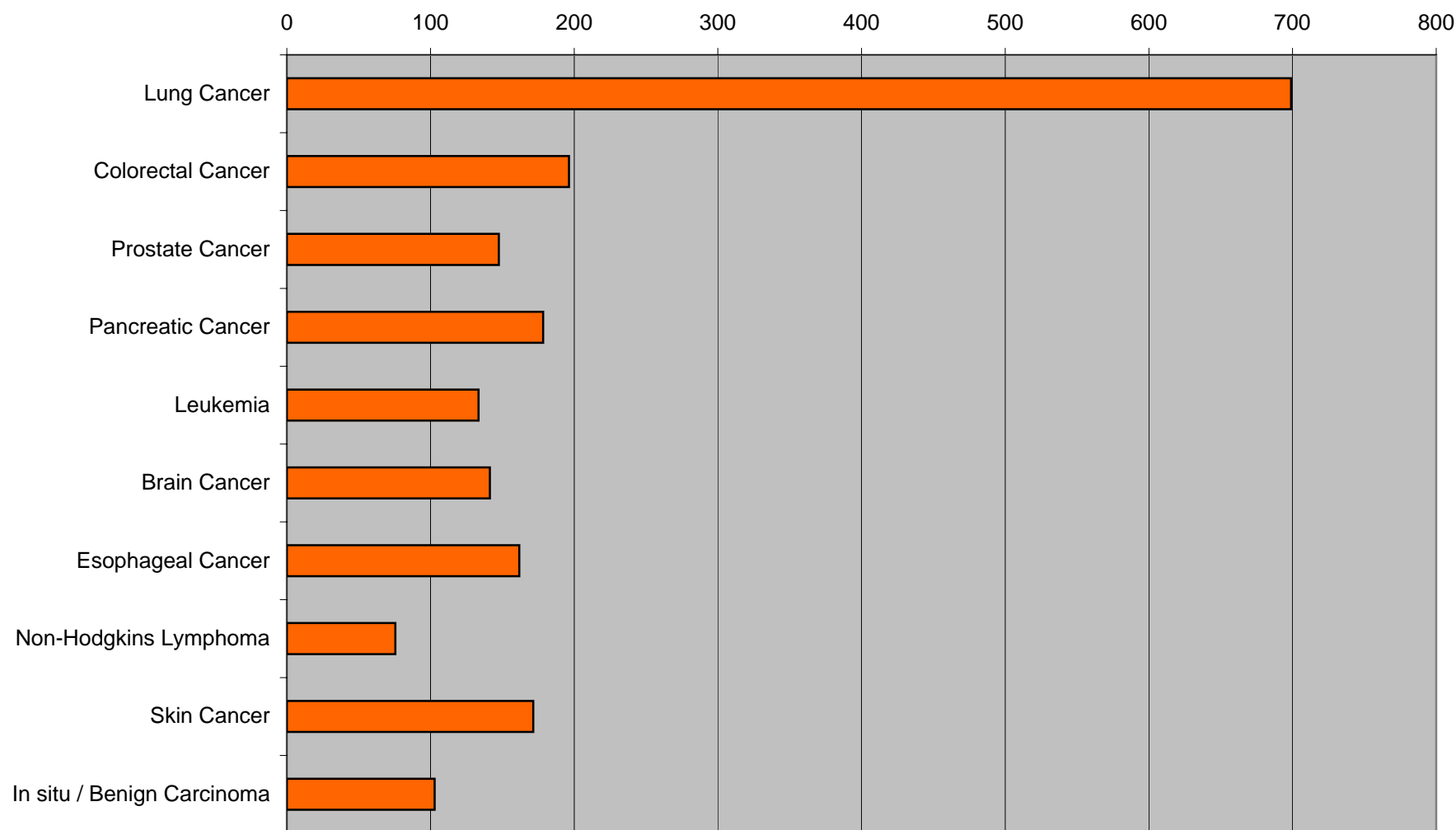
## Significant Causes of Cancer Deaths in Women by Count - 2007



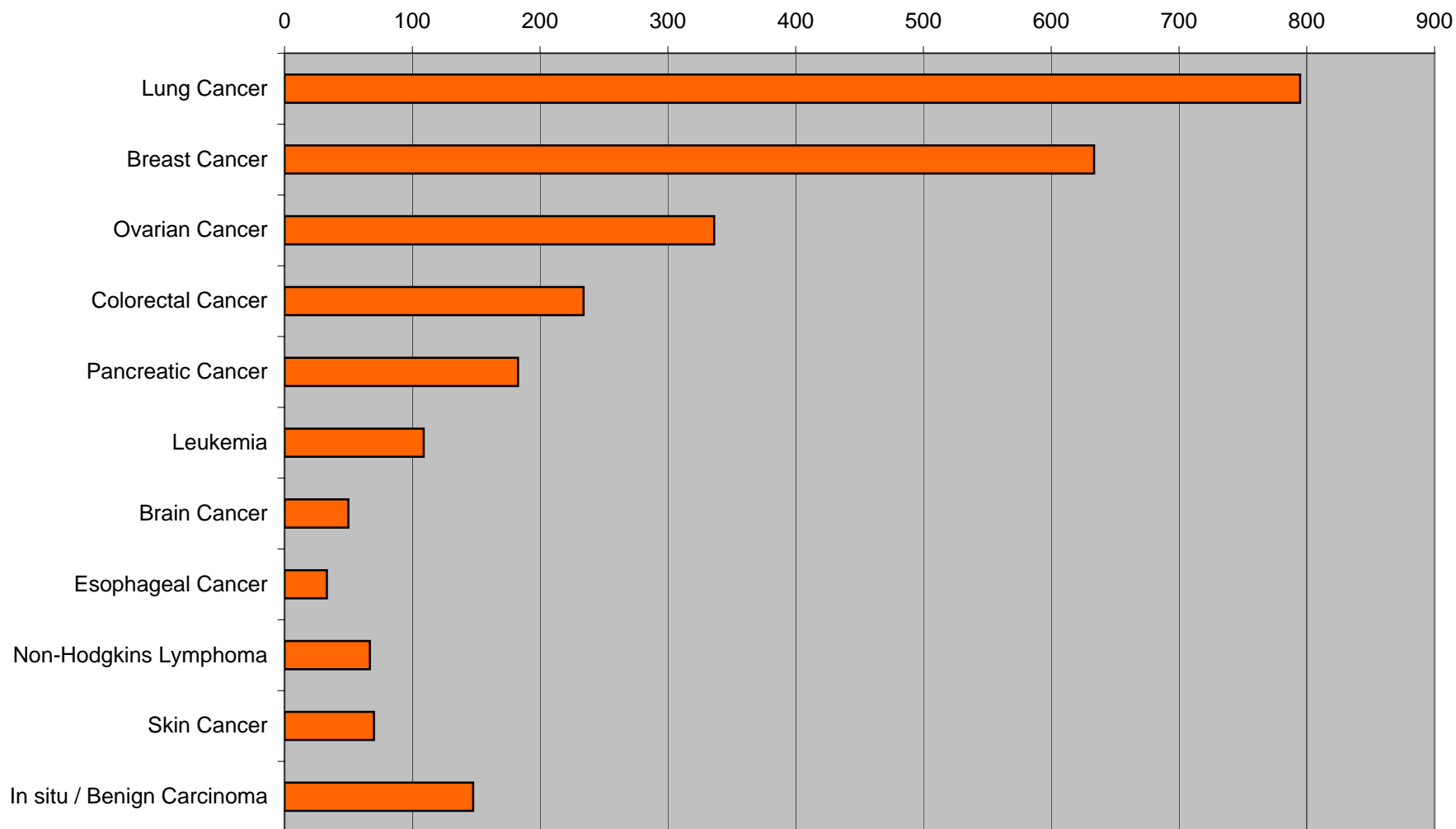

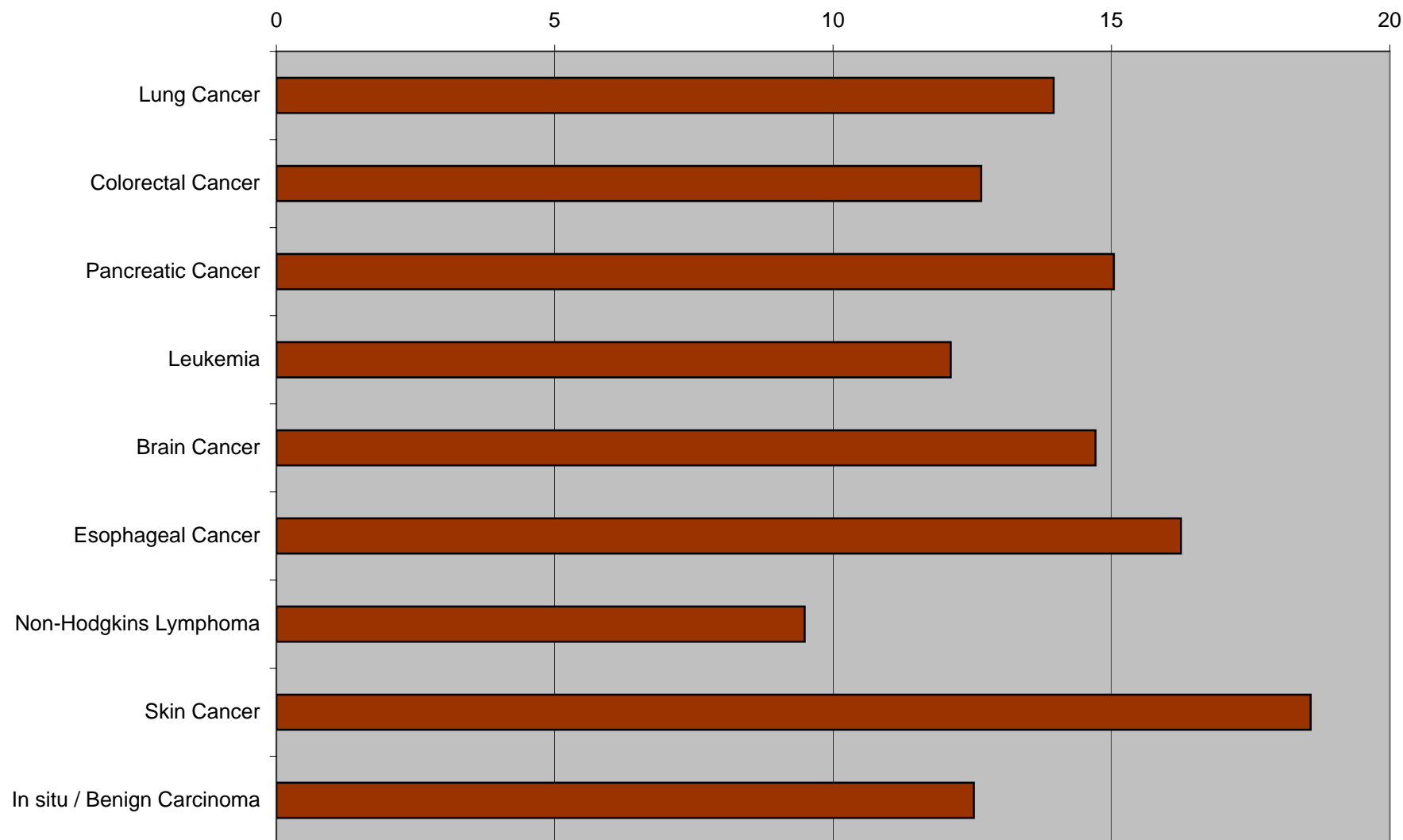

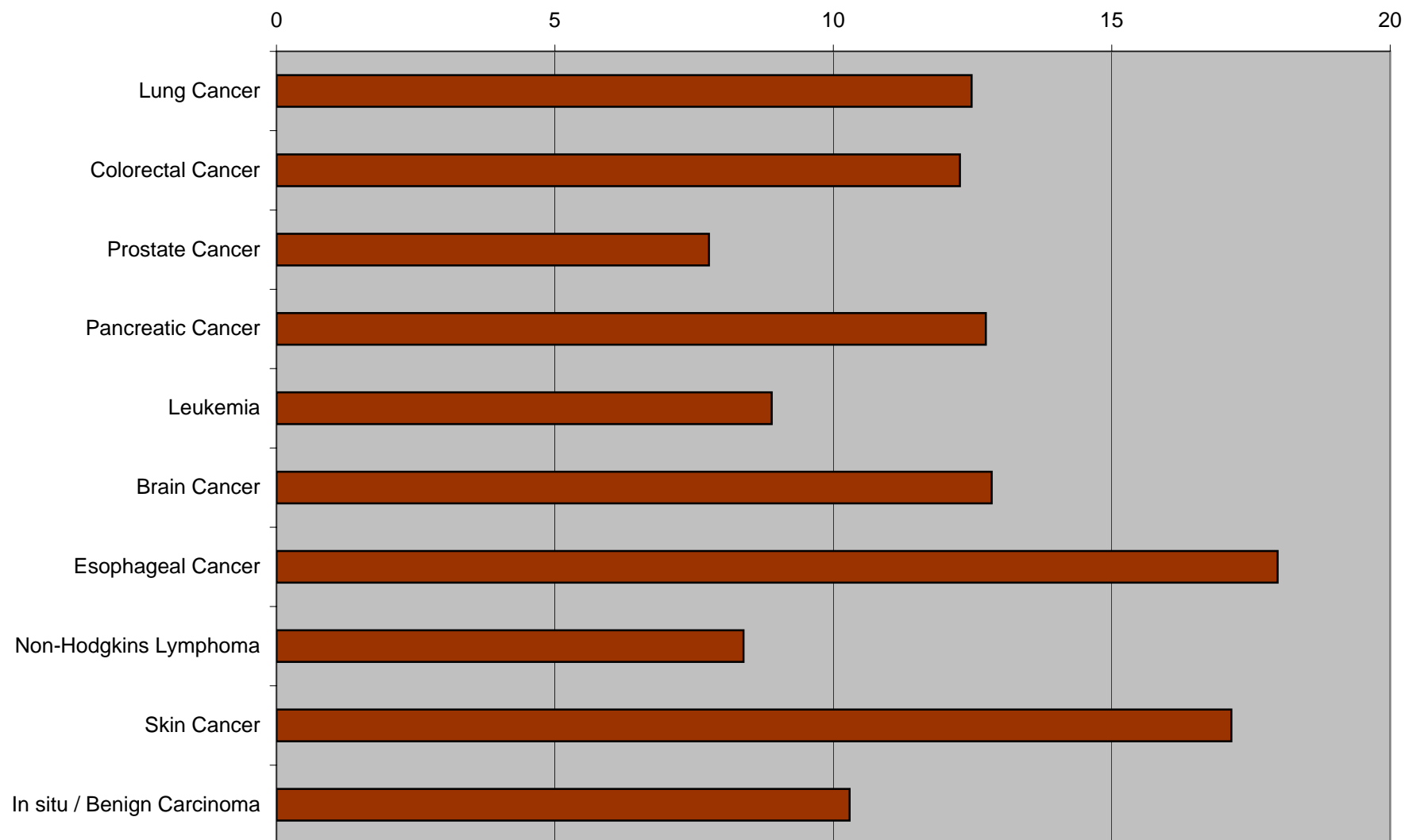


## Average SEYLL by Cancer Type - 2007

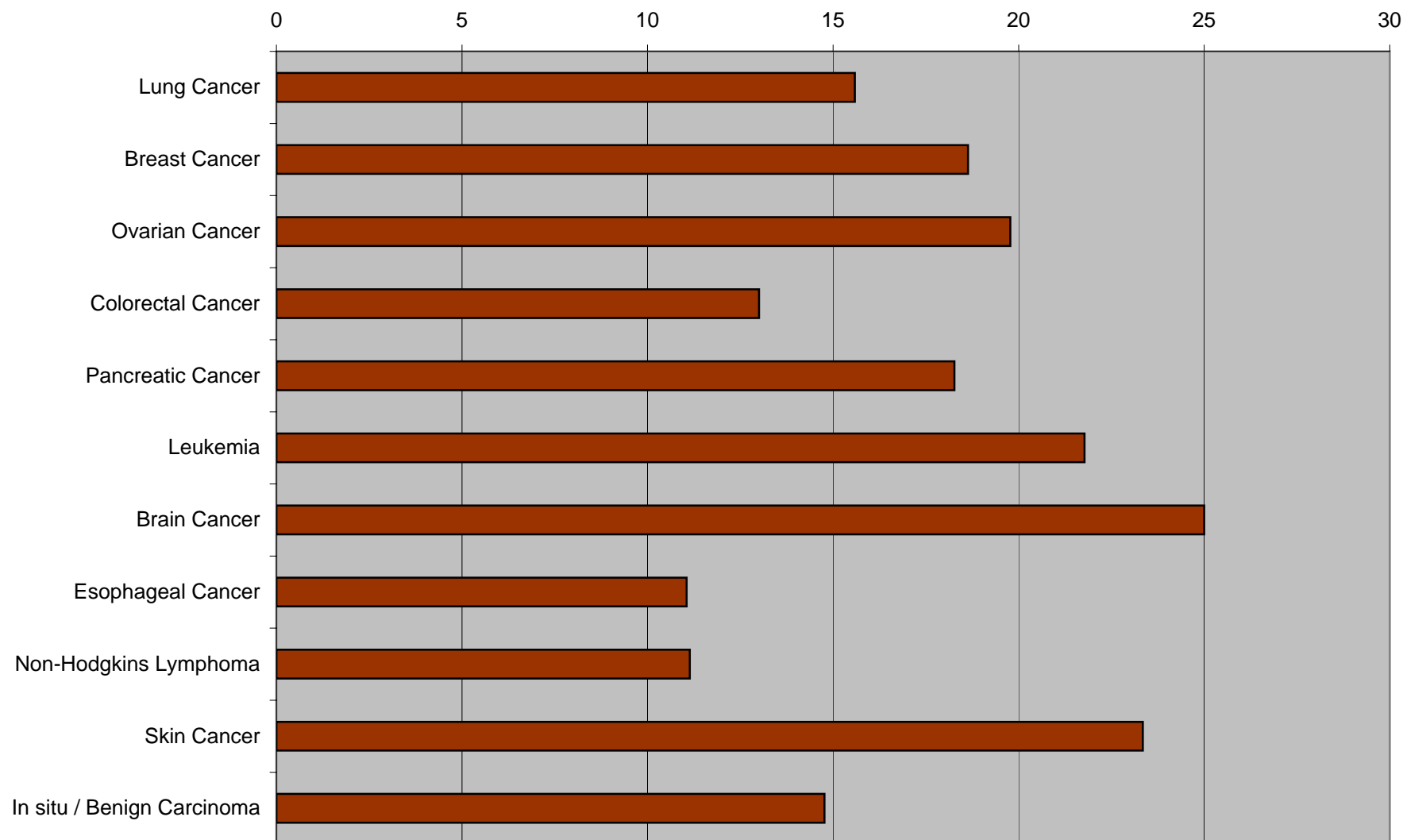




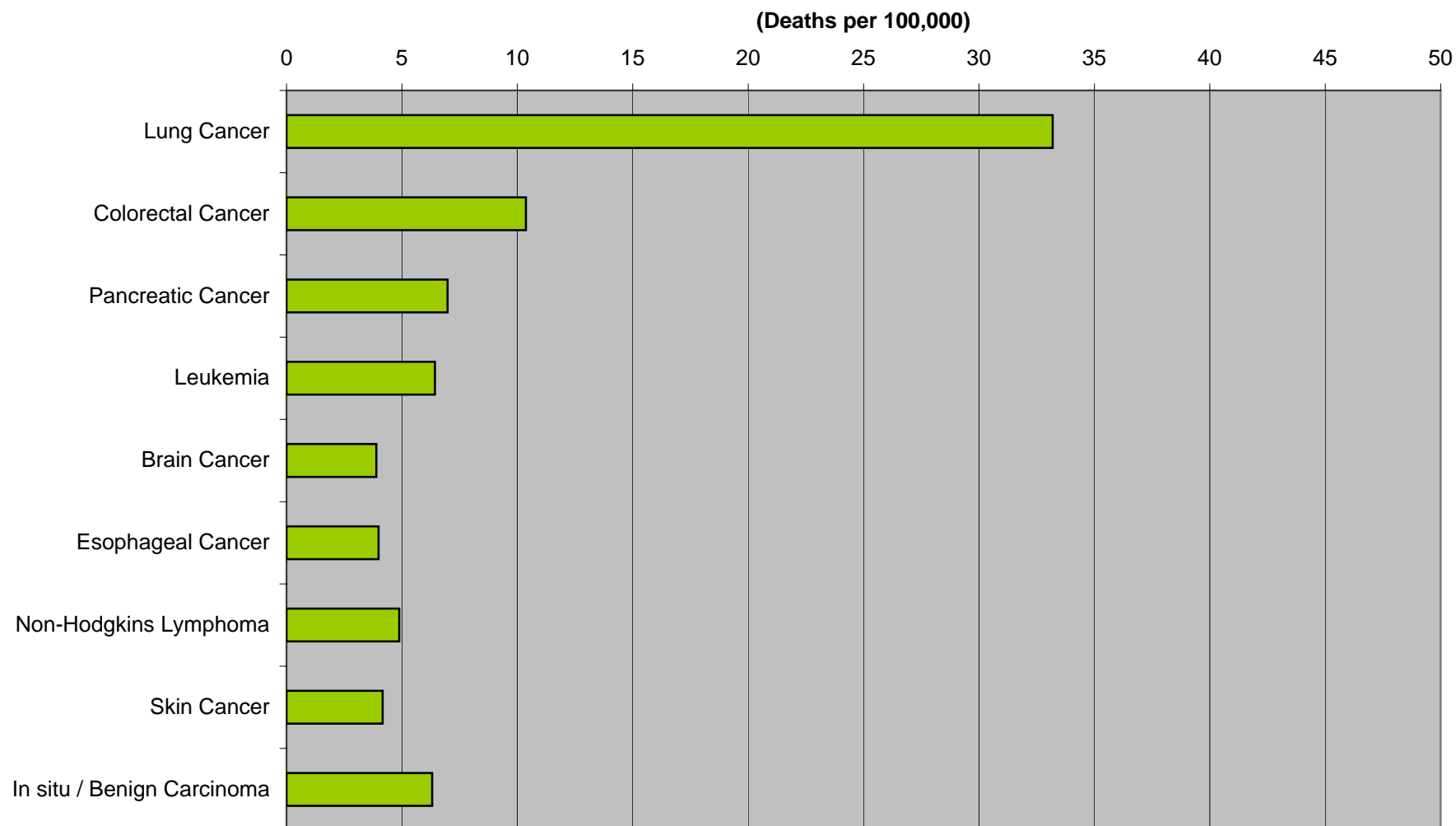
## Average SEYLL by Cancer Type - Men 2007



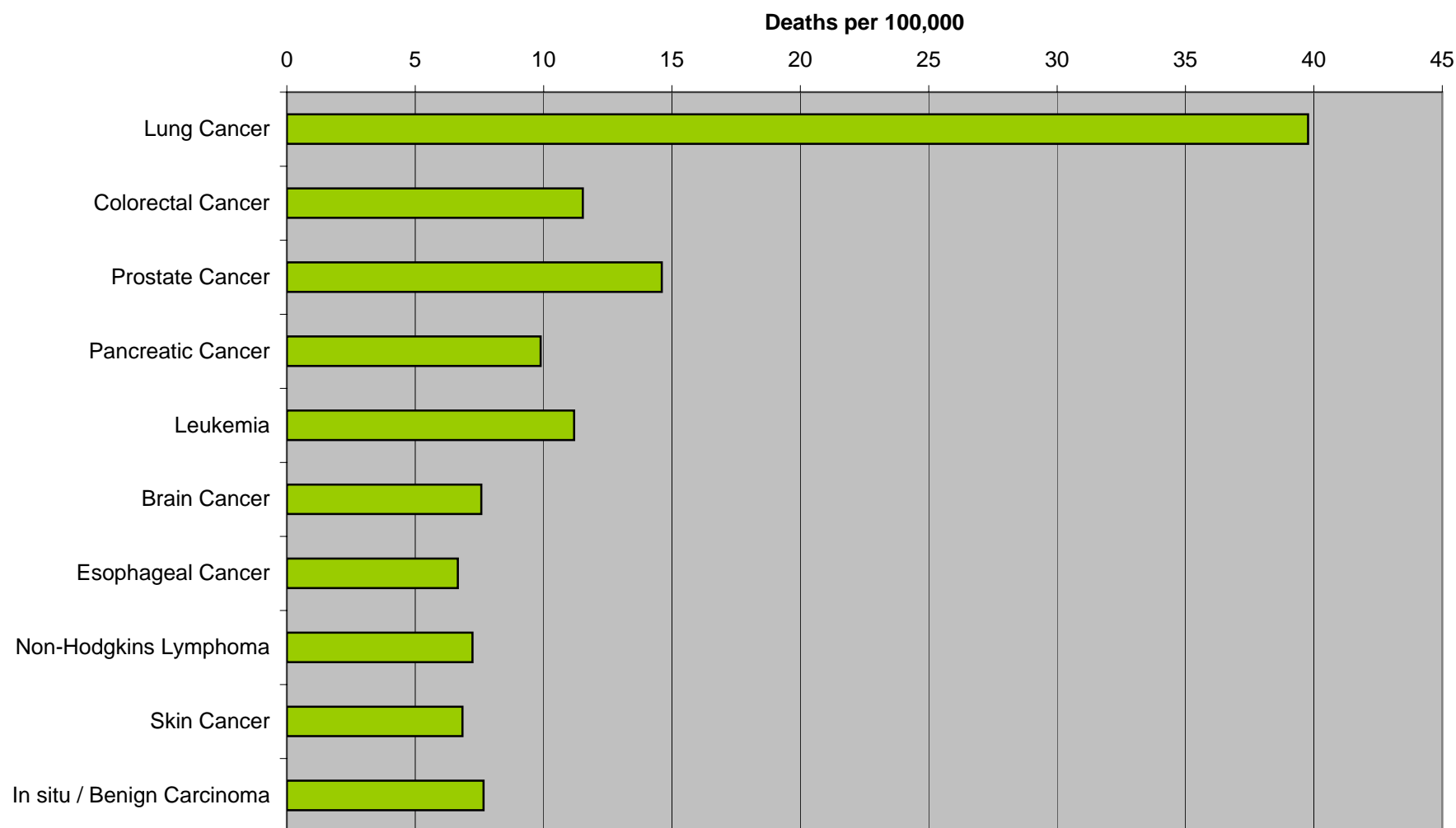
## Average SEYLL by Cancer Type - Women 2007



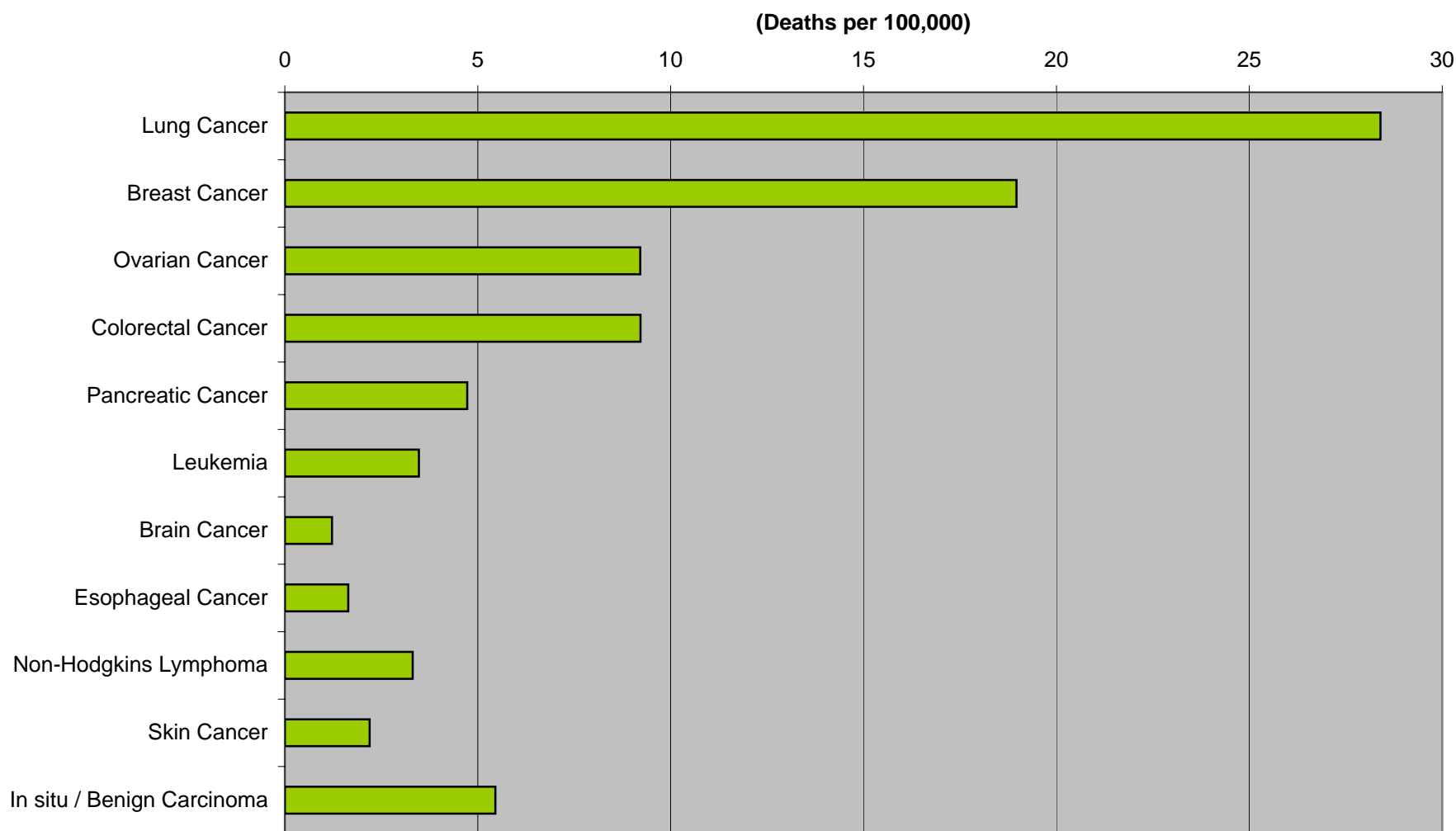
## Significant Causes of Cancer Death by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - 2007



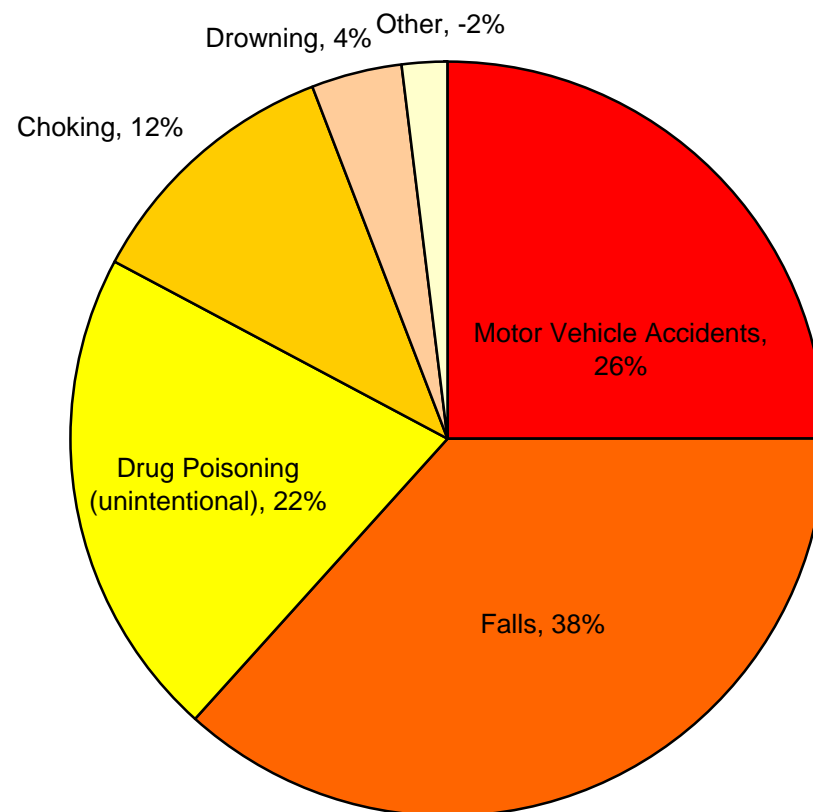
## Significant Causes of Cancer Death for Men by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - 2007



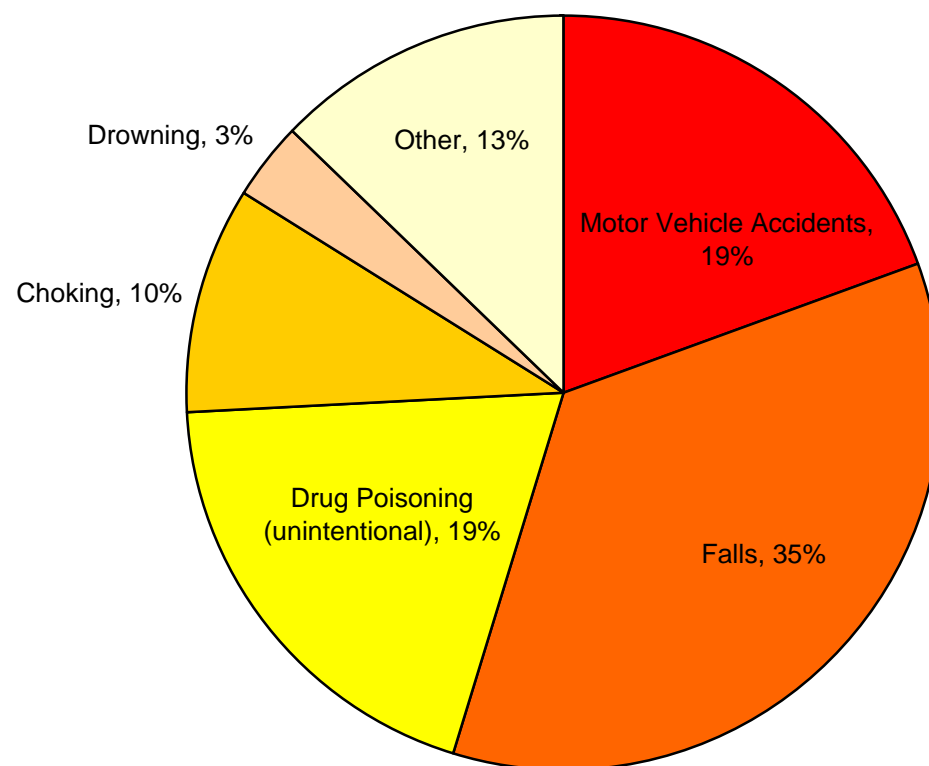
## Significant Causes of Cancer Death for Women by Age-Adjusted Death Rate - 2007



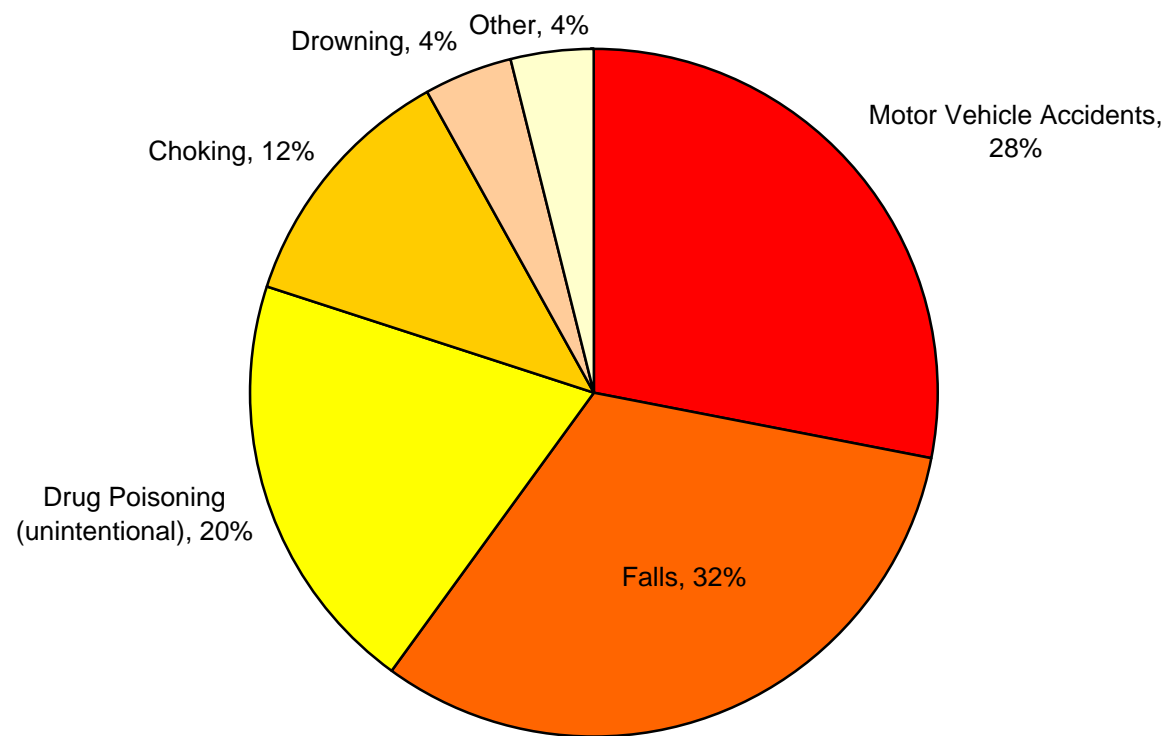
